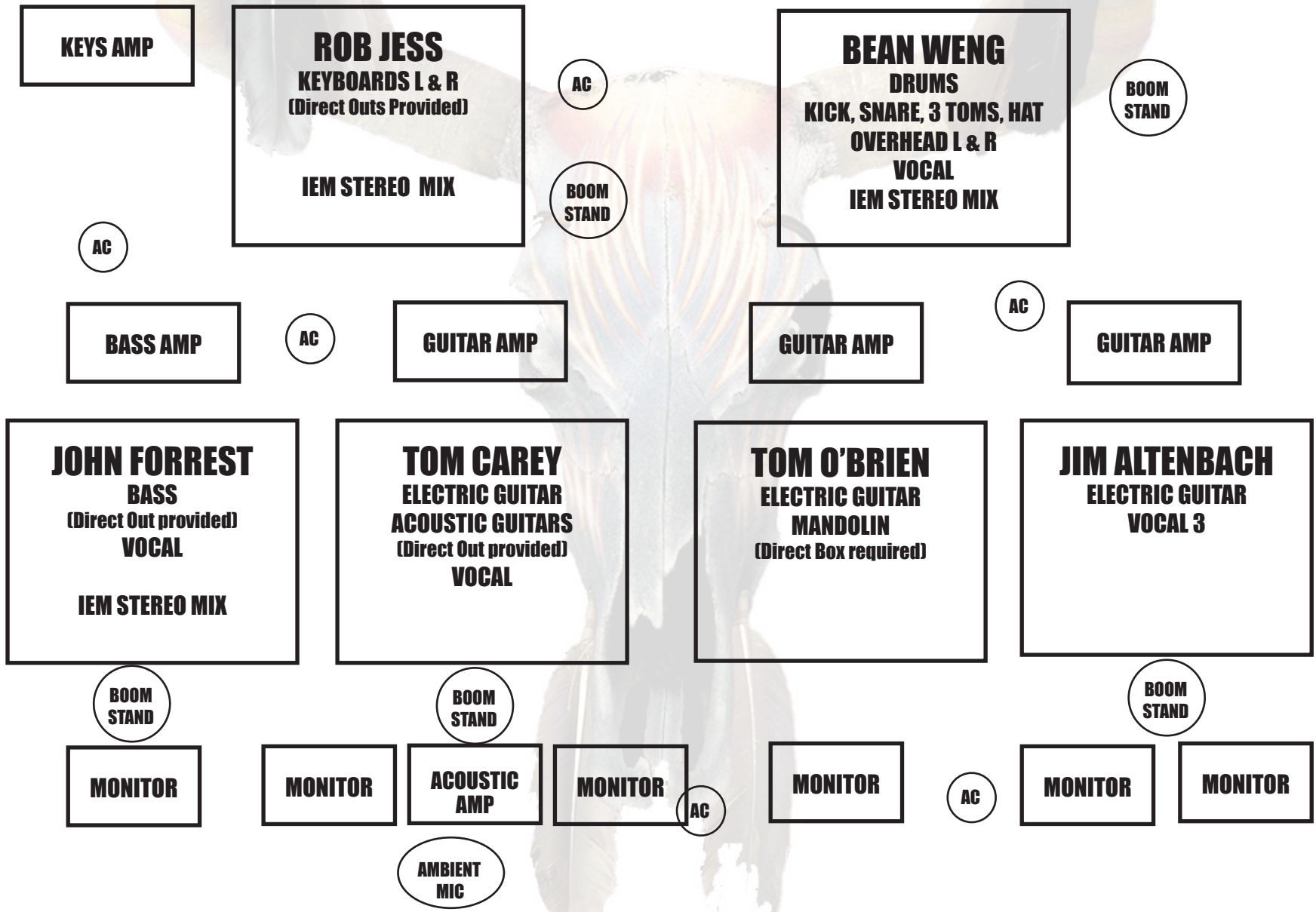


HEARTACHE TONIGHT STAGE PLOT 2025



TECH INFO

Heartache Tonight is a six-piece band; 3 electric guitars, 1 acoustic guitar, keyboard rig, bass and drums (see diagram and photo). We typically travel with our own engineer, **Dale Tulk (tulksound@gmail.com)**. All mics, stands, and input cables are provided unless advanced otherwise. 4 floor monitor mixes required to be patched in from Band Console. Starting at Stage Right to Stage Left: 1 monitor for John Forrest, 2 monitors for Tom Carey, 1 monitor for Tom O'Brien and 2 for Jim Altenbach. Left/Right Mains (Subs)(Front Fills) Patched in from Band console. For safety and sound, it is essential that we have access to reliable electric service. 4 separate 20 amp circuits at a minimum.

Due to the complexity of mixing multiple instruments and vocals it is essential that our sound tech mix Front Of House as well as monitors. Dale is an experienced tech and knows our show!

Please provide two 8' X 8' X 2' (or equivalent) risers, one for keyboards and one for drums. (See Stage Plot for placement). If a lighting scheme is available, we prefer a three-color wash for the stage lighting and 6 specials. Please provide a qualified tech to run lights. We'd like the lighting to highlight what's happening onstage, without being obtrusive. A "ballad" lighting set-up for the more dramatic songs (i.e., Desperado, Best Of My Love, etc.) definitely adds to the experience for the audience. Lighting cues will be provided. We have a slide show/backdrop on flash drive in both PowerPoint or Keynote formats if a projector and screen are available. Or we can provide backdrop photos for your software.

Please provide the easiest stage access possible and parking for our Sprinter van and 7 X 12 ramp door trailer. Extra hands for the heavy lifting are always appreciated. A ramp to an elevated stage is ideal. If the Stage Plot is followed and set-up is complete before our arrival, we can usually do our load-in and sound check in less than two hours.
